"I thought I'd share my daughters recent Science project on Germs vs Anti-microbials. On Guard and Oregano blew the others out of the water!

We tested reg. hospital grade RX hand sanitizer, Bath and Bodyworks hand sanitizer, On Guard, Oregano, Colloidal Silver, Tea Tree oil soap, and had a control dish.

She swabbed the Nintendo Switch Control because who ever cleans that and think of all the kiddo germs 🦠😓 Half of each petri dish of germs was then swabbed down with the anti-microbial and left to incubate for about 5 days on a heat pad and heat lamp.

Most dishes grew a decent amount of germs in the germ side. Some dishes grew germs on both sides BUT the On Guard had only a few specks of germs on the GERM side and NOTHING on the OG side and the Oregano kicked butt with only a minuscule spec or two on the entire dish!

Result! On Guard and Oregano not only did their jobs at fighting the germs on the swabbed side but fought hard at not allowing germs to grow nearly anywhere in the whole dish.

I now add both On Guard and Oregano (along with some citrus oils for scent and freshness) to my spray bottle of half water half vinegar. It's been my go to especially under current circumstances."
